
Meat: frozen beef and chicken. We take wild game as well.

We are now able to help our veterans more and more each day because of

Our count of veterans and their families we have helped since opening in July of 2020, **264**.

Of these Veterans, we have helped: 135 with food, 56 with gas cards,

51 with food cards, 253 with clothing,

107 with furniture, 5 with bikes, 1 with a car,

49 with laundry and/or shower, 4 with phones,

11 with computers, 10 with city bus passes,

17 with hotel rooms, 2 Greyhound bus ticket, and 27 with misc. expenses such as water bills,

car tags, car insurance, & rent deposits.

24 of these veterans have a family and 126 are over 55 years of age.
