VETERANS' ROCK is experiencing growing pains—how wonderful is that! We have become so busy our volunteers can no longer sustain the activities and goings-on each day brings. We have made a decision to hire a Program Manager; someone who can help with all the day to day stuff, lead fundraising,

outreach, to name just a few things. However, we do not have the funding to do this right now so we are asking for your help.

We have opened an account for this very purpose. If you can help "Ensure the Future" for Veterans' Rock, we will, most definitely, appreciate every penny!

# Our count of veterans and their families we have helped since opening in July of 2020, **302.**

Of these Veterans, we have helped:

151 with food, 60 with gas cards, 1 with a car, 52 with food cards, 267 with clothing, 110 with furniture, 50 with laundry and/or shower, 4 with phones, 8 with bikes, 12 with computers, 13 with city bus passes, 18 with hotel rooms, 3 Greyhound bus tickets, and 33 with misc. expenses such as water bills, gas bills, car tags, car insurance, & rent deposits.

25 of these veterans have a family and 127 are over 55 years of age.
