<u>Of these Veterans, we have helped:</u>

212 with food, 162 with gas cards, 38 with food cards, 234 with clothing, 38 nights of hotel rooms, 130 with furniture, 160 with household goods, 22 with bikes, 4 with a car, 31 with car repairs, 49 with laundry and/or showers, 7 with phones, 13 with computers, 56 with gear, 68 with some form of transportation, 46 with direct advocacy assistance, and 41 with misc. expenses for rent , utilities, car tags, deposits, school fees, household repairs, etc.

We are happy to announce Veterans' Rock has given four donated cars to four deserving veterans. We now we have a fifth car to give to a deserving veteran. We are so thankful to those of you who have given us cars to give to veterans!

Moral injury results from perpetrating, failing to act, or witnessing an act that goes against your deeply held values. 40% of combat veterans have experienced it.

Moral injury isn't PTSD but it is related. Moral injury is an invisible wound of the soul that can result in intense shame, agonizing guilt, grief, depression, substance abuse, relationship struggles, anxiety, and suicide.
