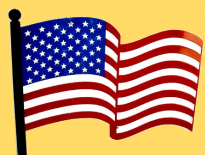
Thank you Rhyatt for donating to our cause here at Veterans' Rock!

Our count of veterans and their families we have helped since opening in July of 2020, **762.**

Of these Veterans, we have helped:

**512 with food, 203 with gas cards,
42 with food cards, 379 with clothing,
53 nights of hotel rooms, 176 with furniture,
215 with household goods,
31 with bikes, 8 with a car,
33 with car repairs,
71 with laundry and/or showers,
9 with phones, 16 with computers,
58 with homeless gear,
86 with some form of transportation,
49 with direct advocacy assistance, and
46 with misc. expenses for rent, utilities,
car tags, deposits, school fees, and
household repairs.**
